Meet the Camp Director, Jerry Block



Jerry Block completed his eighth season as head coach of the men's soccer team at Albion College in 2008. He led the Britons to 44 victories over the past four seasons, including a school-record 14 victories in 2005 and a second-place finish in the ultra-competitive Michigan Intercollegiate Athletic Association in 2006. Block has breathed life into the soccer program, which celebrated placing seven athletes on the 2006 all-MIAA squad.

As a collegiate player at DePauw (Ind.) University, Block finished his four-year career with the second highest point total in Tiger soccer history. DePauw teams compiled a 51-16-5 mark while Block was a member, making the NCAA Division III tournament in 1993 and 1994. Block went on to receive his M.A. in Athletic Administration from Springfield College (Mass.) in 2001, where he served as an assistant coach before arriving at Albion.

The camp staff will also include other college coaches. Members of the Albion College Men's Soccer team will serve as counselors for the camps. We will maintain a camper to staff ratio of 10:1, making sure your son receives plenty of individual instruction.

We strive to create a positive learning environment that fosters individual growth, while at the same time learning how to be a good teammate. The Premier camp is for the more serious player looking to take his game to the next level in preparation for the high school or college season. The morning sessions will involve plenty of technical instruction and skill-building to form a solid foundation, while the afternoon and evening sessions will be devoted to tactical situations and "reading the game." **Individual goalkeeping instruction will also be available.** Campers are encouraged to come to camp with a good level of fitness as sessions will demand their physical and mental best. Many drills and games utilized are similar to those we use for the Albion College varsity squad. Premier camp will be a great springboard to your fall season!
